**Project Description:** A Metro Parks electro-hock boat was used to stun and collect fish from the lake. These fish each had a scale removed to help determine the age of the fish, then the fish were measured, weighed, and released, the purpose being to know the health of the fish in the lake and to help determine what fish to stock in the lake in the future. Meanwhile the majority of the Scouts cleared invasive honeysuckle bushes from a stretch of shoreline for park development. Some of the bushes were tied to cinder blocks, and the boat brought them out on the lake and sunk them to create submerged fish habitat.
