

Troop 560 Packing List 2005

Wear Clothes

Hiking Boots
Hiking Socks (socks + liners)
Zip off pants
Tee Shirt
Long Sleeve Shirt
Belt

In Top of Pack

Rain Jacket (or wear it)
Rain Pants
Gloves
Hat
Pack cover

Pack Clothes

Sleeping Clothes – pants , shirt, long or short or fleece depending on cold or warm
(Note: pack your sleeping clothes, including underwear and socks in your sleeping bag)
Zip off pants (2nd pair)
(2) pairs of underwear (to be clean and dry each night)
3 pairs of socks (to be clean and dry each night)
Shirt – long sleeve
Shirt – short sleeve
If Cold – Insulated underwear, sweater, sweatshirt
Remember - layers to take off

Misc Gear

Sleeping bag (packed in plastic or waterproof stuff sack)
Sleeping mat
Troop stakes
2 Liters of Water , +1 liter of troop water (+2 for Adults)
Groundcloth for troop tent
50 feet of rope cut into 10 foot sections
Knife
Compass
Whistle
matches
Extra zip lock bags and extra large trash bags
Spoon, fork, or spork
Bowl / plate, Cup
Toothbrush, toothpaste
Bug spray – non aerosol (in its own small zip lock)
Flashlight with fresh batteries
Camp Soap (coordinate with patrol)
Note: Keep all smellables in one zip lock, labeled with your name to go into bear bag

Optional Gear

Sun screen
Wash cloth, small towel
Camera
Extra straps

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Troop Gear

Your part of Tent

Your part of patrol gear

Patrol *oil and spices* for cooking

Patrol Food (note keep all food in one place for ease of bear bag)

For Red River Gorge we need a “Return Pack” – a small backpack with clothes to change in

to:

Pants

Socks

Shoes

Shirt

Sweatshirt

Deodorant

Underwear

Wash cloth / towel

Additional Troop Gear for Patrols:
